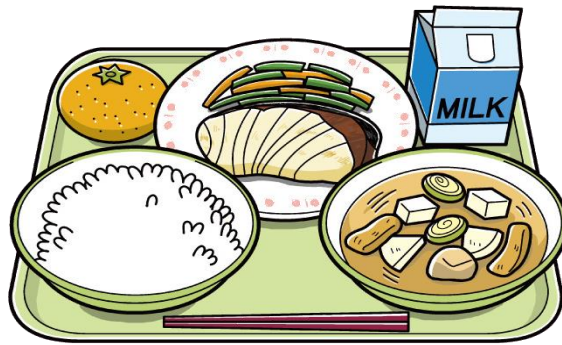

●Meals

Rice : Mon, The, Wed (every other week)
Thu (rice grown Hiroshima prefecture)
Bread: Friday
Noodles: Wed (every other week)
With bread



●Fresh milk

Everyday. Contains Protein, Calcium, Vitamin etc. These nutrients are essential for children's growth.

●Side dishes

Two or three main dishes (meat, fish, eggs, beans, etc.) and side dishes (vegetables, etc.) are served. Dessert and fruits are sometimes served
