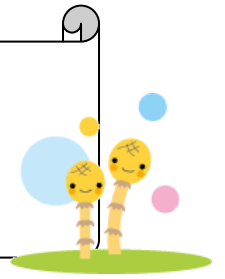


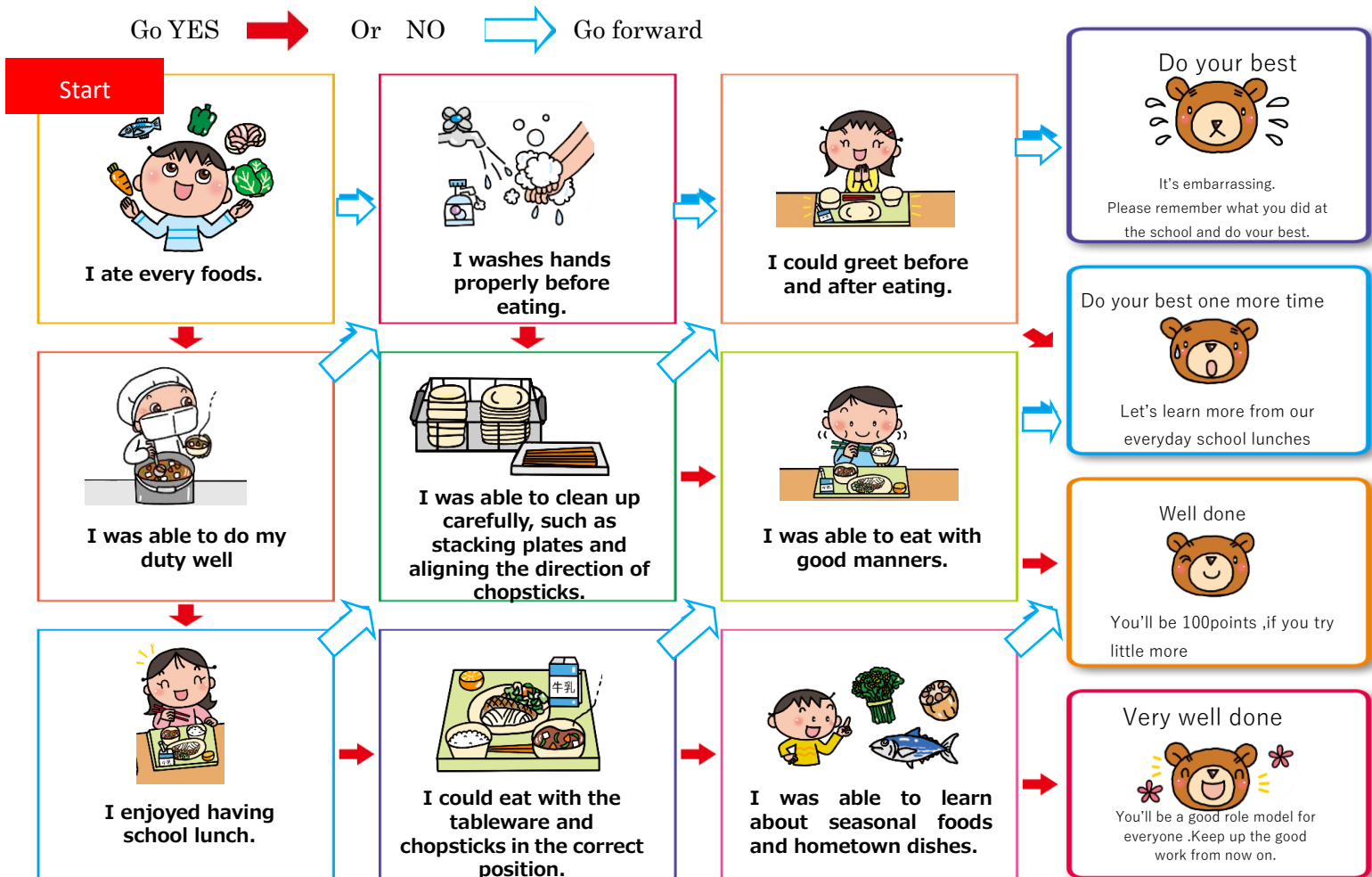

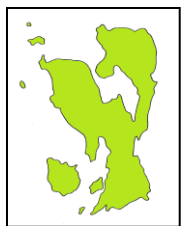


March, the month of spring, is the last month of the school year. How was your school life over the past year?
